We had hoped to get definitive results last Wednesday, but it was not to be. The doctor ordered several more tests and another follow-up visit for June 3rd. At that time we hope to be able to get some high powered contact lenses for him. We want so much for him to be able to read from his printed Bible and the hymnbook. It would be such a blessing for him and for us. He is a zealous servant of the Lord. Please pray for him.

Since our weather has improved, we have had numerous opportunities to get out in the park and witness, and are looking forward to many more, plus our scooters will soon be back in action delivering the Good News to every mailbox in our region. We are looking forward to a productive time.

March 27th marked the 9th anniversary of my arrival in Croatia. Time sure passes quickly when you are living your dream serving the Lord!

The Leslies will return in two days, and we are very much looking forward to that. Praise the Lord we have survived their nearly six month furlough, and we even had one person added to our number during their absence! God is good!

The last week of this month I will be in Romania participating in a Medical Mission Outreach, as sort of a working vacation for me. A group of medical professionals and others from the US come and set up a free clinic in cooperation with a local missionary, and invite the community. Then, everyone who comes in for treatment is given the opportunity to hear a Gospel presentation from one of the local missionaries or church members. I'll be assisting in the clinic in whatever way I can. Please pray for this effort that souls might be saved.

Thank you so much for your support, whether financial, or through prayer and encouragement. Without you, this would not be possible. Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing.
